**WHEREAS**, Resolution 2024-0398 set salaries for Deputy Prosecuting Attorneys and Public Defense Attorneys; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board desires to remove the Deputy Prosecuting Attorneys from the resolution setting salaries for the Office of Public Defense; **NOW THEREFORE**,

**BE IT RESOLVED**, resolution 2024-0398 is hereby rescinded; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the Benton County Commissioners affirm the following salary placements on the Benton County Non-Bargaining Salary Schedule:

Deputy Prosecuting Attorney I	Grade 19
Deputy Prosecuting Attorney II	Grade 22
Deputy Prosecuting Attorney III	Grade 25
Deputy Prosecuting Attorney IV	Grade 27

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the Benton County Commissioners affirm the following salaries as a percentage of the Elected Prosecuting Attorney's Salary:

Assistant Chief Deputy	75% of Elected
Chief Deputy	80% of Elected

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the Prosecuting Attorney follow the Benton County Personnel Policies and Procedures and Budget Policies and Procedures for initial placement or advancement of Attorneys; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, all exceptions to the initial placement or advancement of Deputy Prosecuting Attorneys must be approved by the Board of Benton County Commissioners on a case-by-case basis, in accordance with the Benton County Personnel Policies and Procedures.
