

SECURITY VIDEO CAMERAS IN COURT

Security video cameras are allowed to be placed in the courtroom for security purposes only.

The cameras will be placed in a manner that will prevent recording and/or viewing of the jury box in all courtrooms.

The cameras will record only video. Audio recording is not allowed.

Recording and viewing of all areas of the courtroom is allowed with the exception of the jury box. There will be no recording or viewing of the jury box.

The system currently in place records to an array of hard drives that is configured to write over past recordings once the hard drives are full. The system also has the capability of allowing the user to export and save still images and defined segments of video. That functionality shall not be changed without approval of the Superior Court.

Still images and segments of video shall not be viewed, exported and/or saved unless authorized in writing by a Superior Court Judge pursuant to a request made under the Judicial Records Act – GR 31.1.
