Discussion and Possible Decision – Memorandum of Understanding with Teamsters Local 839, Representing Corrections Officers and Correction Clerical Employees – Regarding Sick and Vacation Leave Cash Out for Employees Subject to Reduction in Work Force Terminations

Lexi Wingfield presented the Memorandum of Understanding between Benton County and Teamsters Local 839 to allow employees being termed January 1, 2021 to cash out sick and vacation as previously discussed. The agreement was approved to form by the PA's office and signed by the union.

Ms. Wingfield reiterated this was not precedent setting, nor did it change language in the current contracts, and was very specific to this situation.
