Main Topics Discussed

Other Business: CARES Act Funding for COVID-19 Response – Adam Morasch, Risk Manager

The Benton County Administrator and Risk Manager presented to the Commissioners regarding COVID-19 safety measures taken by the County, including providing face coverings, installing plexiglass to protect public-facing employees, providing personal protective equipment, placement of signage regarding COVID-19 regulations and requirements, and providing employees with updates and information regarding COVID-19. Due to COVID-19, many of the Risk Manager's regular day-to-day duties have fallen by the wayside. The Administrator and Risk Manager are requesting approval from the Commissioners to use the CARES Act funding received by the County to fund a temporary position, through the end of 2020, to assist the Risk Manager with day-to-day operations and other duties as assigned during the COVID-19 pandemic. **The Board moved and seconded to approve the resolution and line item transfer to fund a temporary Risk Management position from the CARES Act funding. Motion carried.**
