

RESOLUTION

BEFORE THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BENTON COUNTY, WASHINGTON:

IN THE MATTER OF RE-ESTABLISHING THE BENTON COUNTY LAW AND JUSTICE COUNCIL, DEFINING AND APPOINTING MEMBERSHIP, AND RESCINDING RESOLUTION 93-147

WHEREAS, Chapter 72.09.300 authorizes a county legislative authority to establish a local law and justice council; and,

WHEREAS, the Benton County Law and Justice Council was created by resolution 93-147 wherein initial members were appointed; and,

WHEREAS, tracking of membership on the Council has become increasingly cumbersome, therefore necessitating the rescinding of resolution 93-147 and the re-establishment of the Benton County Law and Justice Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED that membership of the Benton County Law and Justice Council shall be as follows:

- a. One designee of each municipal police department within Benton County including Richland, Kennewick, West Richland, and Prosser;
- b. The city attorneys from Richland, Kennewick, West Richland, Prosser, and Benton City (or their designees);
- c. One designee of each city legislative authority within Benton County, including Richland, Kennewick, West Richland, Benton City, and Prosser;
- d. One designee from the Benton and Franklin Superior Courts;
- e. One designee from the Benton Co. District Court;
- f. The following Benton Co. officials or their designee:
 - Prosecutor
 - One Benton Co. Commissioner
 - Sheriff
 - Jail Captain

- g. The Secretary of the Washington Department of Corrections or his designee; and,
- h. A minimum of three additional members from the public at large who are Benton County citizens not employed by Benton County or any city in Benton County shall be appointed by the Benton County Board of Commissioners; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the membership roster for the Council shall henceforth be maintained and updated by the Board of Commissioners. Members are required to provide, in writing, to the Board of Commissioners their names and the name(s) of their designees should they desire to have a designated representative(s); and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that resolution 93-147 is hereby rescinded.
