13.01.010 PURPOSE. This chapter is enacted to protect the health and safety of the public from the threat of accident, theft or sabotage within the WNP-2 Exclusion Area.

13.01.020 DEFINITIONS. The following terms, as used in this chapter, shall mean:

(a) "Firearms, explosives or incendiary devices" means any type of weapon or device from which a projectile may be fired by an explosive either loaded or unloaded, and/or any shell, bomb or similar device, charged or filled with one or more explosives.

(b) "WNP-2 Exclusion Area" shall mean the area in Benton County located within 1950 meters of the WNP-2 Reactor Containment Building, which is in the Northeast quarter (NE 1/4) of the Southeast quarter (SE 1/4) of the Northwest quarter (NW 1/4) of Section 5, Township 11 North, Range 28 East, Willamette Meridian.

13.01.030 RESTRICTIONS. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited within the WNP-2 Exclusion Area.

No person except law enforcement officers authorized to carry firearms may introduce or possess any firearms, explosives or incendiary devices within the WNP-2 Exclusion Area.

13.01.040 VIOLATIONS - PENALTY. Any person violating any provision of this chapter shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished, upon conviction, by imprisonment in the County jail for a maximum term fixed by the court of not more than 90 days or by a fine in an amount fixed by the court of not more than one thousand dollars or by both such imprisonment and fine.
