2.16.015 DESIGNATION OF STOCK RESTRICTED AREAS. The following described areas within Benton County are established and designated as stock restricted areas:

- (a) Area A - Beginning at a point where the East line of Section 1, Twp. 13 N. Range 25 EWM., intersects the Columbia River; thence South to the Southeast corner of Section 12, Twp. 13 N., Range 25 EWM., thence West along the section lines to the Northeast corner of Section 14, Twp. 13N, Range 24 EWM; thence South to the Southeast corner of said section 14; thence West to the Southwest corner of Section 15, Twp. 13N, Range 24 EWM; thence North to the Southwest corner of Section 10, Twp. 13N, Range 24 EWM; thence West to the Southwest corner of Southeast quarter (SE**3**) of the Southeast quarter (SE**3**) of Section 9, Twp. 13N, Range 24 EWM; thence North to the Columbia River, said river being the Northern boundary of the district, all situated and being in the County of Benton, State of Washington.
- (b) Area B - N**2** of Section 23, S**2S2** of Section 24, Section 25, and Section 36, all in Township 11 North, Range 24, E. W. M.;
- Lot 4 in Section 19, S**2S2** of Sections 21, 22, and 23, and Sections 26 to 36 inclusive, all in Township 11 North, Range 25, E. W. M.
- (c) Area C - Beginning at a point where the Township line between Townships 10 and 11 North of Range 28 E.W.M.

intersects the Columbia River; thence Westerly on the Township line between said Townships 10 and 11, a distance of approximately 28² miles to the Range line between Ranges 23 and 24 E.W.M., said line being the Westerly boundary line of Benton County, Washington; thence Southerly on said Range Line between Ranges 23 and 24 E.W.M., a distance of approximately 24 miles to the township line between Townships 6 and 7; thence East on the Township line between said Townships 6 and 7 a distance of approximately 22 miles to the NW corner of Section 2, Township 6 North, Range 27 E.W.M.; thence South approximately 4² miles to the center point of the West boundary line of Section 26, Township 6 North, Range 27 E.W.M.; thence east approximately 1 mile through center of said Section 26 to the center point of its East boundary line; thence South along section lines approximately 3² miles to the bank of the Columbia River; thence Easterly, and continuing along the Columbia River to the point of beginning;

2.16.020 LIVESTOCK AT LARGE IN STOCK RESTRICTED AREAS PROHIBITED. It shall be unlawful for any person owning or in control of livestock of any kind to willfully or negligently allow such livestock to run at large within the stock restricted areas described in Section 2.16.015 of this chapter or to allow such livestock to wander or stray upon the right-of-way of any public highway lying within such stock restricted areas when not in the charge of some person.

2.16.030 PENALTIES. Any person, or any agent, employee or representative of a corporation, who violates any of the provisions of this chapter shall be guilty of a misdemeanor. Each day any of the provisions of this chapter are violated shall constitute a separate and distinct offense.
