6.24.015 DEFINITION. For the purposes of this chapter, "maintained county road right-of-way" shall mean that portion of a road right-of-way maintained by Benton County for public travel which extends from the bottom of the ditch or the bottom of the fill slope, as applicable, on one side of such right-of-way to the bottom of the ditch or the bottom of the fill slope, as applicable, on the other side of such right-of-way.

6.24.020 WATER ON MAINTAINED COUNTY ROAD RIGHTS-OF-WAY PROHIBITED. No person, firm or corporation shall cause or permit any irrigation water or waste water to fall upon, run upon, run across, or accumulate upon any maintained county road right-of-way or portion thereof in Benton County.

6.24.030 VIOLATIONS - PENALTIES. Any person violating any provision of this chapter shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be punishable upon conviction, by a fine of not more than \$1,000.
